

## NEW SERVICE FROM CRUISE WHITSUNDAYS

Cruise Whitsundays have just announced a new transfer service to connect Hamilton Island Airport and Whitsundays Coast Airport (Proserpine) to Daydream Island Resort and Spa commencing April 1st 2006. The service will also be available to South Molle Island guests and any visitors staying in Airlie Beach properties, arriving through Hamilton.

Timed to give the best possible connection with all flights, "Resort Connections", will provide seamless, hassle free and faster connections for arriving and departing guests from both airports with two brand new, purpose built vessels.

The new service will operate directly from the jetty at Hamilton Island Airport with departures as close as possible to touchdown. Resort Connections will also provide a personalised meet and greet service at Proserpine Airport. Passengers will board a dedicated coach which will connect directly to a transfer vessel at Abel Point Marina. The Marina is just 5 minutes from Airlie Beach town centre.

Co-owner and director Chris Jacobs said "Resort Connections is designed to get guests to their resort as quickly and as easily as possible. In almost all instances, guests will get to their resort a good deal quicker than on currently offered services and departing guests similarly will have a shorter connection time. We want guests arriving in the Whitsundays to feel like they are on holiday from the minute they step on board."

Launched this week 'Barracuda' and 'Swordfish', designed and built in Brisbane for Cruise Whitsundays, are 19 metre catamarans with a capacity of 123 passengers and a cruising speed of 24 knots. Features include air-conditioning, large plasma screens to provide information on the resorts and area, a cafeteria and bar.

Resort Connections is the latest venture by Cruise Whitsundays who operate quality day cruises throughout the Whitsundays. The parent company, Marine Tourism Holdings (MTH), also owns South Sea Cruises in Fiji where they have operated "Resort Transfers" for many years in the Mamanuca Islands.
