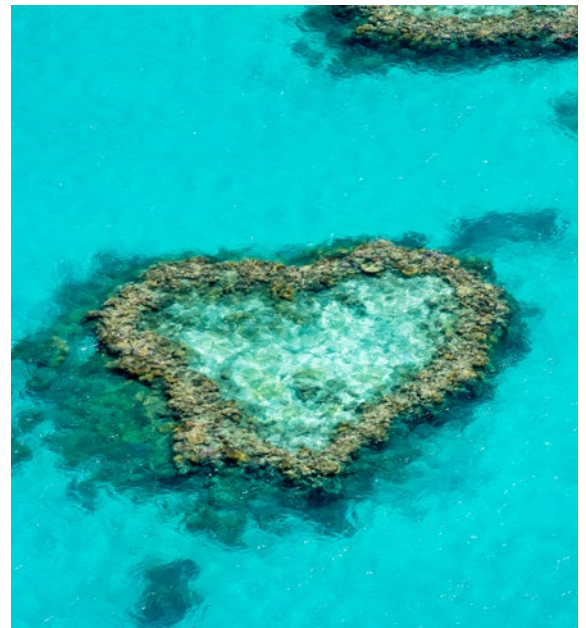
*PLEASE NOTE: Bookings for heli-scenic flights are taken on board the vessel. Minimum numbers and weight restrictions may apply.*
